Classic City Tours in Stockholm

1. Description 4 hours including one visit to museum:

Meet with your local guide and coach at pier in the morning for an exciting sightseeing in Stockholm. We will show you most famous buildings and views, including a stop at Fjällgatan, where the view of Stockholm's islands and waters is truly wonderful. You will pass famous sights include the Royal Palace, the Parliament Buildings, City Hall and the church where our crown princess were married in June.

We will have a short stop to visit the old town and the cobbled alleys behind the royal palace.

Cross the old royal hunting grounds on Djurgården island, where a string of magnificent mansions line the shore. Today, Djurgården is part of Stockholm's national city park. Here you will find the famous Vasa Museum, here you will have one hour to visit the museum inside.

2. Description 8 hrs including two visits: Vasa Museum and City Hall:

Meet with your local guide and coach at pier in the morning for an exciting sightseeing in Stockholm. We will show you most famous buildings and views, including a stop at Fjällgatan, where the view of Stockholm's islands and waters is truly wonderful. You will pass famous sights including the Royal Palace, the Parliament Buildings, the old market place and much more.

Cross the old royal hunting grounds on Djurgården island, where a string of magnificent mansions line the shore. Today, Djurgården is part of Stockholm's national city park. Here you will find the famous Vasa Museum, here you will have one hour to visit the museum inside.

The [Vasa Museum](#) is Scandinavia's most visited museum. In the large ship hall stands the warship Vasa - the only remaining, intact 17th century ship in the world. The lower rig has been rebuilt, complete with masts, stays and shrouds.



Have a walkabout in [old town](#). This unique district in Stockholm dates back to the 13th century, and consists of medieval alleyways, streets, and archaic architecture. Here you also will find the Royal Palace, and the church where there will be a royal wedding in June 2010. Thoroughly brushed up during spring the beautiful church will shine as in old days. Maximum 30 people per guide.

(Optional you can take the ferry from the Old town to Djurgården and the Vasa Museum)

Before you go back to the ship visit the impressive building [The City Hall of Stockholm](#). This is one of the most beautiful and well-known buildings in the world and the most exclusive ballroom in Stockholm, frequently used for e.g. the yearly Nobel Banquet. Behind the brick walls, several different activities take place.

Time Schedule:

Panoramic 2-3 hours

Old Town, 1 – 1,5 hours (optional visits in the design shops – old market hall)

Vasa Museum 1 hour

City Hall 1 hour

Lunch – 1 hour (pre paid or paid on spot with credit card or Swedish cash)

Budgets estimate for lunches from SEK 150 per person depending on demands



Alternative inside visits during these tours

[Skansen Open Air Museum](#) where over the years about 150 historical buildings have been moved here from nearly every of Sweden. Most of them date from the 18th and 19th centuries. Located just near the Vasa Museum in Djurgården island.
