



Panoramic Copenhagen City Tour

Meet with your guide and coach for a visit to Copenhagen where we would like you to see Wonderful Copenhagen this dynamic and diverse metropolis which can trace its history back to the Viking Age. Copenhagen boasts picturesque medieval city centre surrounded by rapidly developing urban area. Ørestaden – a new part of Copenhagen with modern architecture and exciting buildings.

During the past decade a major effort has been made to revitalize the inner harbour and integrate the wharfs with the rest of the city centre. Old industrial buildings have been transformed into residential housing and newly built offices, cultural institutions and apartments have given life to the area.

Copenhagen is considered one of the world's most environmentally friendly cities. Recently the trend magazine Monocle nominated Copenhagen as the world's best city in which to live and now the city is once more in the very top.

The tour will take you to the Gefion Fountain, Amalienborg Palace (winter residence of the Royal family), the King's New Square and Nyhavn, the Royal Theatre and the Opera, The Old Stock exchange, Christiansborg (the Danish Parliament) The Town Hall Square, The Tivoli Gardens and The New Carlsberg Glyptoteque, possibly the canals of Christianshavn.

The Black Diamond (Royal Library) (photo stop) – is another success of combing new and old wings. This black cubic building is designed with black glass and situated at the waterfront. This glass formation make the water reflect in a very spectacular way and make this mastodon of a building very light.

The Paustian House (photo stop) – a creation by Jørn Utzon himself. An elegant building in bright colours very characteristic for Utzon, located at the waterfront in a tough harbour area.
